Preserve Area

The preserves within the community are protected areas and are to be preserved. There have been some problems with people entering these areas and disturbing the wildlife there. Soon signage will be installed indicating that there should be no entry into these areas. No yard waste is allowed in these areas as well.

Mailbox Painting

The mailboxes on the Drive will be painted soon. An email will be sent when this is completed as you will need to access your box soon afterward to avoid the door sticking shut.

Pressure Washing Reminder

Pressure washing of the community's Miami gutters and common area sidewalks is now complete. Please make sure you have completed the pressure washing of sidewalks in front of your home as well as your driveways by the middle of January. The property manager will be doing a walk through at that time.



Picnic Pavillion

A new 20x24' picnic pavillion, similar to the one pictured above, will be installed over a rubber enclosed surface with two picnic tables underneath. The structure's roof will be a darker colonial red with Canterbury pillars, not what is pictured. It will be located behind the mailboxes on the Drive set back about 20' with a walkway. There will be no playground equipment or refuse cans there. Installation of the new pavillion is now being scheduled.
